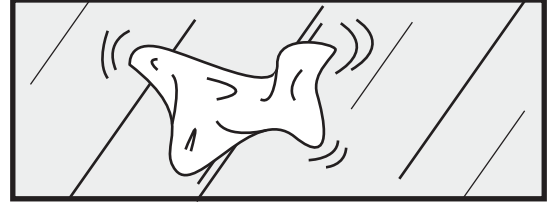


# APPLYING VINYL DECALS

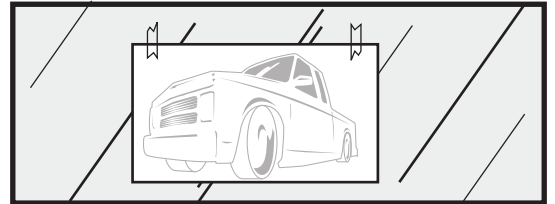
## Clean the Surface

Use a dry cloth to clean the surface. If necessary use rubbing alcohol to remove stubborn dirt or grease.



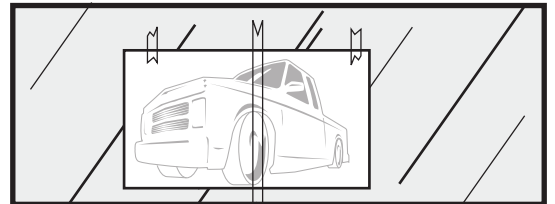
## Secure the Decal

Tape the vinyl graphic in place and measure from different points to ensure that it is positioned exactly where you want it located. If edges are taped over edge either trim or peel the tape back so you can remove the backing later on.



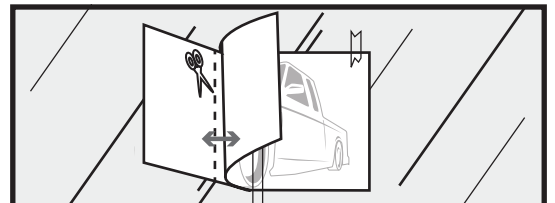
## Tape in Place

Once you are satisfied with the position, apply another piece of tape across the top of the vinyl graphic or through the middle.



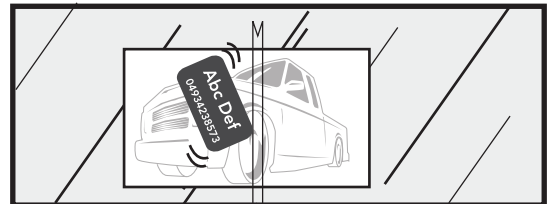
## Remove Backing Paper

With the tape functioning as a hinge, flip the vinyl graphic around and carefully remove the backing paper from the transfer tape. If you went through the middle remove one half and trim the backing paper and move to the next step.



## Apply the Graphic

With the graphic in place, apply pressure with a credit card/bank card. Working from the center to the edge, evenly force the air from beneath the image. If your working in halves go back a step and do the other side.



## Remove Transfer Tape

Remove the tape from the top of the graphic. Now carefully peel away the transfer tape. Any bubbles that developed under the decal should go away after time out in the sun or you can use a small pin and pop the bubble and push the air out with your thumb.
